2 Productisation Overview

2.1 Purpose

The JCSE Item Images for Transactions bundle enables image to be displayed on any standard transaction via the use of Advanced PDF functionality.

2.2 NetSuite Gap

NetSuite does not natively pass image URLs through to transaction lines, meaning there is no URL at line level to include in an Advanced PDF template

2.3 JCS Extension Solution

The JCSE Item Images for Transactions bundle allows up to 6 images to be attached to the item record. When the item record is updated (via the interface, CSV import or other method) the file URLs are added to the item record.

Using an Advanced PDF Template, the URLs are accessible and able to be displayed on standard transactions.



3 User Procedure

3.1 Adding Images to Items

Adding images to an item can be done via

- 1. User interface
 - a. Edit the item record
 - b. Select the Item Images subtab, and select the required image in one of the Image or Thumb fields.
 - c. Save the record. When viewed after save, the URL for each image should be displayed below the image.

2. Via CSV update

- a. Ensure all required images have already been uploaded to the file cabinet.
 - i. Note: please ensure images are ticked for "Available without Login", or they may not render correctly on PDF documents.
- b. Add the image filename (as uploaded to the file cabinet) to the required image or thumb fields
- c. After successful CSV update, the URL should be updated on each update item record.

3. Matrix Items

- a. When updating a matrix parent item, it should be noted that changes to the image and/or URL **will** propagate down through selected matrix child items.
- 4. Options on the item record:
 - a. Default Image
 - The user may select which of the uploaded images will be included on the transaction by default. Select the prefered image in this field under the Item Images Subtab
 - ii. If no image has been added to the item, nothing will display.
 - b. Image Display Height & Width
 - i. In the Image Display Height/Width fields, the user should indicate the display size of the images in either mm (millimeters) or px (pixels). This will default to 20mm for each dimension.
 - ii. This cannot be changed dynamically on the transaction
 - iii. Advanced PDF templates cannot resize images dynamically
 - iv. Consistent image sizes are recommended, however this field should be used to main the image size is displayed proportionately on the PDF output.

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




Item Record: Item Image Subtab

3.2 Using Images on Transactions

- 1. This bundle is supplied with a default Quotation Entry form called "1 JCurve Quote w/Image Selection". It is preconfigured with custom fields to include the Image Selection on the transaction lines.
- 2. When viewing a saved Quotation transaction, a small preview thumbnail will be visible on each line. This column field may be hidden if the customer does not require this preview.

4 Installation & Preferences

4.1.1 Bundle Installation

1. Bundle Details

a. Account: JCurve NetSuite AU Bundle Deployment - Primary

b. Name: JCSE Item Images for Transactions

c. ID: 252179d. Managed: Yes

2. Custom fields, workflows, and scripts are deployed from the bundle repository. Custom fields are set to "Show on Existing Custom Forms". Fields will need to be hidden on other transaction forms where they are not required (ie. Transactions other than Sales Orders and Item Fulfilments).

4.1.2 Custom Preferences

1. Setup > Company > General Preferences > Custom Preferences

- i. Under subheading JCSE Item Images for Transactions
 - 1. Populate the base URL for your NetSuite account
 - 2. Set the defaut image with and height.
 - a. Defaults to 30mm
